Application for Membership

An aspiring member must be sponsored by a member and must sign an application form. This application must then be given to the administrative secretary who shall present it to the executive council of the Local Lodge for approval. Club membership is only transferable upon death only.

Types of Membership

All members of the Order of the Sons of Italia shall be known as Brothers and Sisters.

There are five (5) classes of membership, which are:

- a) Member - must be over the age of 18 years and must be a member in good standing with the Order and with the mutual benefit society of the Order Sons of Italy of Canada. Current members in good standing—regardless of which family individual is a member—all relatives within that family (Son, Daughter, & Grand-children, married or not, living at home or not) are eligible to become members by paying the \$50 (\$25 over 65) including H.S.T. annual fee.**
- b) Social Member - those who, because of their national origin, are not admitted as active members. They may participate in social, athletic and cultural activities sponsored either by the subordinate lodges or the Grand Lodge. They are entitled to attend meetings of the lodge, but not entitled to participate in the discussion of the lodge without the permission of the Venerable, and not entitled to vote or hold office.**
- c) Youth Member - is anyone under the age of eighteen (18) years or one who is in full time attendance at an institution of learning and is still under the age of twenty-five (25) years.**
- d) Meritorious Member - is one who has received a certificate of Merit from the Grand Lodge.**
- e) Honorary Member - is one who has received a certificate as an Honorary Member from the Grand Lodge.**
